Dear Mr. Hill:

This letter concerns the request, filed on August 26, 2008, and on behalf of Proctor-Williams, Inc. ("Proctor"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit AM Station KSET to remain silent.


Commission records reflect that station KSET(AM) went silent on January 18, 2008, because it was in the process of implementing a major construction permit change (BMP-20061122AIO). An STA to remain silent was granted on February 20, 2008, and expired on August 18, 2008. Proctor requests an extension of its STA and states that the process to move the equipment from the authorized site to the new site has begun. Proctor's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Proctor's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KSET(AM) to remain silent for a period not to exceed January 18, 2009. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for KSET(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if**

broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. on January 19, 2009.¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

Finally, the station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Additionally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's towers shall be maintained. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
