Mr. Bradshaw:

On September 8, the FCC issued a letter in the above-captioned matter.

Soon thereafter, I approached respondent K243BN several times without success to set a date for joint signal testing.

On October 20, Respondent Mountain Community Translators presented an FMX interference remediation plan letter (see below) to the Commission.

The letter reports that while conducting unilateral measurements and testing, Mr. Michael observed K243BN causing interference to the off-air reception of station KIKO-FM.

This result is not surprising as we find that it is consistent with the substance of the KIKO-FM listener complaints submitted in this proceeding.

The full content of the October 20 letter was not shared with me or petitioner 1TV.com, Inc., in advance of its filing with the Commission. 1TV.com, Inc. does not accept, and reserves comment on, a number of assertions made in that letter.

However, Mr. Michael notified us a few days in advance of the letter that to remediate the interference, K243BN was taken silent and a CP application was filed seeking a channel and XM site change.

We observe that both proposals were filed and granted in LMS - see below.


These two remediation proposals are acceptable to KIKO-FM, <u>provided</u> that K243BN remains silent until operations commence as authorized in File No.000201900.

The October 20 letter pledges to construct the modified facilities as soon as action is taken on the modification application.

Please advise if the Bureau requires any further information from 1TV.com, Inc./KIKO-FM in reply to your September 8 letter.
