

Dear Counsel:

This is in regard to your letter of September 27, 2006, filed on behalf of KCHN Licensee, LLC, requesting calculation of presunrise and postsunset operating power for Station KCHN(AM), pursuant to Section 73.99 of the Commission's rules.

Our calculations indicate that, due to protection requirements to cochannel Class A Mexican Station XEG, Monterrey, Nuevo Leon, neither presunrise nor postsunset operation by Station KCHN employing the currently licensed daytime antenna system is permissible.<sup>1</sup>
