Request to Extend STA

Multicultural Radio Broadcasting Licensee, LLC Station KXPA(AM), Bellevue, Washington November 2022

KXPA(AM) Narrative

MULTICULTURAL RADIO BROADCASTING LICENSEE, LLC ('MRBL'), RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF KXPA(AM)'S SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORIZATION ('STA') TO OPERATE AT TWENTY FIVE PERCENT (25%) OF ITS LICENSED POWER IN THE NON-DIRECTIONAL MODE DURING NIGHTTIME HOURS. THIS REQUEST IS NECESSARY BECAUSE THE ELECTRICAL WORK FOR SOUND TRANSIT'S LIGHT RAIL TRAIN STATION IS IN ITS FINAL PHASE.

ALTHOUGH CLOSE TO FRUITION, THE SOUND TRANSIT PROJECT STILL EFFECTS THE ELECTRICAL ENVIRONMENT AND OPERATION OF KXPA. SINCE FILING ITS MAY 2022 REQUEST TO EXTEND ITS STA, MRBL HAS ADVANCED THE KXPA TECHNICAL PROJECT AND CAN REPORT SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS. KINTRONICS FINISHED BUILDING THE KXPA REPLACEMENT PHASER, IT WAS DELIVERED ON SITE AND INSTALLATION IS UNDERWAY. CONSTRUCTION OF THE EAST AND WEST TOWERS IS FINISHED, AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE NON-DIRECTIONAL CENTER TOWER IS IN PROGRESS. MRBL IS HOPEFUL THAT HATFILED & DAWSON WILL BE ABLE TO START THE FINAL PHASE OF MODELING AND TUNE-UP OF THE ARRAY AFTER THE FIRST OF THE YEAR. BARRING INCLEMENT WEATHER, MRBL PLANS TO HAVE THE KXPA DIRECTIONAL ANTENNA SYSTEM RESTORED BY SPRING OF 2023.

IN THE MEANTIME, MRBL RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF ITS STA, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 73.1635 AND 73.1680(A)(1) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES, TO OPERATE KXPA WITH TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT (25%) POWER IN THE NONDIRECTIONAL MODE DURING NIGHTTIME HOURS. MRBL WILL MONITOR THE IMPACT OF THE SOUND TRANSIT PROJECT CLOSELY AND, IF ADDITIONAL TECHNICAL ADJUSTMENTS ARE NECESSARY, MRBL WILL INFORM THE COMMISSION.
