Recently Construction Permit BP-20220407AAH was issued to WTAL-AM for new, modified permanent facilities. Substantial progress has been made towards building out Construction Permit BP-20220407AAH as noted in the attached email chain between FCC counsel, the applicant and its engineering consultant.

As engineer Chris Hall describes in his attached email dated December 23, 2022, the build out of Construction Permit BP-20220407AAH is expected to be completed during January 2023.
