
Dear Madam Secretary:

On the behalf of **EDI Media, Inc.**, ("EDI"), the Licensee of KWRM (AM), Corona, California (FAC# 39692) ("KWRM"), this is to respectfully request an Extension Special Temporary Authority ("STA") granted in BESTA-20220621AAB. As previously advised, EDI lost its tower site and is now operating from a temporary location at reduced power. EDI has located property to move the KWRM to, and has filed for a construction permit to that site (See BP-20211110AAD)("CP"). Attached hereto is an update from EDI's consulting firm on the CP project. EDI is getting close to finalizing matters for the new site and an extension is necessary. Under the circumstances, the EDI respectfully requests an extension of time in which to operate at reduced power for a period of 180 days.

Attached please find the required Ant-Drug Certificate signed by Counsel. Pursuant to FCC *Public Notice*, DA 22-29, (released January 11, 2022) (the "Public Notice") this instant STA Request is being submitted by e-mail to audiofillings@fcc.gov.

Mr. Trent,

The undersigned has been hired by the referenced licensee (EDI, Inc) to build out a new transmitter location for KWRM Radio in July of 2022. An acceptable piece of land abutting the Chico Airport, San Bernardino, California has met siting and coverage as well as FAA-No Hazard, and we assisted EDI in preparing the application for leasing the property which was submitted, accepted and approved by San Bernardino County in October of 2022.

In late November of 2022, I was contacted by Lyle Ballard, the Leasing and Property Manager for the referenced County that that actual location for the CP for the new site would not fit in to their planned layout and offered two other parcels, within very close proximity (under 400 feet from the original filed-for site), and one was chosen.

A minor change to the CP application is in the process of being filed, as well as a determination of No-Hazard from the FAA.

The Commission Rules state that in order to get an ASR number for the new tower, a complete environmental study (NEPA) must be undertaken by EDI and that will be commenced immediately upon a lease signing for this changed parcel, which is expected to be undertaken on January 5, 2023.

We have coordinated a grouping of technical experts who will guide the construction, including Tom Gorton of Hatfield & Dawson, PE (Seattle, WA), Doug Lawrence of Tower Engineering Professionals, Inc. who will do the actual survey of the site for accurate placement of the tower structure and necessary anchor points; Environmental Corporation of America (GA) who will undertake the necessary archaeological and NEPA processes, and the actual construction of the transmitter plant by Robert Burnham, Senior Engineer with BRC Broadcasting, Dearborn Heights, Michigan. The actual work in progress should begin on Monday, January 9th, 2023 providing the land lease signing is executed on January 5th.

Depending on the time for the environment study report, and the issuance, therefore of the ASR which would provide the necessary documentation for a CP to be issued based on the slight revision of the CP applied-for site, we will be certain that a proper and timely return to the air at the applied-for power level will be expedient and properly done.


