Dear Mr. Su:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 4, 2023. EDI requests a further extension of the STA granted on December 23, 2021, to continue operating from an alternate site using a temporary antenna (due to loss of the licensed site). In support of the request, we noted that EDI stated that they plan to file an amendment to the pending application BP-20211110AAD to change the site and engineering parameters (since the originally planned site is no longer viable).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and EDI may continue to operate with the following facilities:
