Dear Mr. Self:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 10. 2023. SRMG requests a final extension of the STA granted on August 9, 2010, to continue operating from an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 applications for co-located stations WLAY and WVNA.¹ In support of the request, SRMG stated that it plans to complete all remaining work as soon as possible in order to file both applications.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and SRMG may continue to operate with the following facilities:

¹ WVNA(AM) is licensed for operation on 1590 kHz with 5 kW ND (day) and 1 kW DA (night), and BP-20200814ARG authorizes ND operation from a new site with reduced power.

SRMG must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on July 11, 2023.
