Requested STA Purpose: Engineering STA Technical Specification: Licensed Antenna System with Other Variance

Explanation of Special Temporary Authority (STA) Request for a Licensed Antenna System with Other Variance.

WCRV(AM) - Collierville, TN (640 kHz) is licensed to operate from a common daytime and nighttime site with a daytime non-directional daytime power of 50.0 kW and a nighttime two-tower directional power of 0.480 kW. Nighttime tower two (southwest tower; ASRN 1043822) of the two-tower nighttime array serves as the daytime non-directional tower. WCRV(AM) operates under License BL-19910906AC / BZ-20130924AJV.

On January 5, 2023, a failure of a nighttime contactor switch occurred, rendering the nighttime array inoperable. As a result, operation into the nighttime directional array is not possible at this time. Repairs are scheduled to occur within the next few weeks. Therefore, special temporary authority will be necessary during this interim period.

WCRV(AM) therefore requests emergency nighttime special temporary authority from the daytime non-directional site using 0.120 kW of non-directional power. 0.120 kW of non-directional power represents one quarter (1/4) the licensed nighttime directional power of 0.480 kW, as allowed per 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1680(b)(1).

Given the licensed (BZ-20130924AJV) daytime non-directional antenna resistance of 50 ohms, this nighttime STA of 0.120 kw non-directional will operate with an antenna current of 1.55 amperes.

No special authority is required for the licensed daytime non-directional operation.

Regarding environmental compliance, the applicant certifies RF compliance of this STA request for 0.120 kW of nighttime non-directional operation from the present daytime non-directional tower. As WCRV(AM) presently operates from the tower with 50.0 kW of non-directional power during the daytime hours; this additional 0.120 kW nighttime non-directional STA request from the same tower will categorically fall within the present fencing limits.

Regarding compliance with the Nationwide Programmatic Agreement and NHPA Section 106 for tower co-location, compliance with the Agreement is not required where no new tower construction is being proposed and the tower is not being substantially altered. Specifically, compliance is not necessary where only an existing AM, NDA tower daytime tower is being used for nighttime STA purposes as here. However, should the Commission determine compliance is necessary, upon notification to the applicant, the applicant will file FCC Form 621.

Therefore, temporary operation at a variance from the Commission's rules is believed merited (1) with regard to the broadcasting facility showings of 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.24(e), 73.24(g), 73.33, 73.45, 73.150, 73.152, 73.160, 73.182(a)-(i), 73.186, 73.189, 73.1650; and nighttime protection showings as required by 47 C.F.R. Section 73.182. No STA provisions are required for daytime operation at this time; (2) with regard to public interest, this STA operation will allow WCRV(AM) to provide service during the repair process rather than request silent authority and remove an existing aural service from the community; and (3) the expected duration of this STA is not expected to exceed 180 days of operation. Construction/repairs above the nighttime base pier and insulator will not occur, with full restoration of nighttime licensed parameters expected. However, if licensed parameters cannot be restored, the licensee will file a Form 302-AM direct measurement of power upon completion of the contactor repairs notifying of any changes to the nighttime antenna monitor parameters which may result.

Regarding any necessary Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification, the applicant certifies that neither the applicant nor any party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
