REJECTION OF PARTIAL GRANT and

REQUEST FOR DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION

Dear Ms. Dortch

I am writing on behalf of our client, the University of South Florida ("USF"), licensee of Station WUSF(FM), Tampa, Florida, with respect to an October 29, 2008 letter from the Commission which granted the above-referenced application "in part" with an effective radiated power of 78 kilowatts, instead of the requested 79 kilowatts. Pursuant to Sections 0.110 and 73.3568(c)of the Commission's Rules, and for the reasons which follow, USF respectfully rejects this partial grant and requests that the subject application be dismissed without prejudice. An original and four (4) copies of this letter are being filed.

USF greatly appreciates the Commission's efforts to make the subject application grantable by slightly reducing the proposed effective radiated power. However, upon further reflection, USF does not deem it prudent to make the requested transmitter site change at the present time. Therefore, it prefers to have the subject application dismissed without prejudice and its pending Form 302-FM license modification application for Station WUSF granted (File No. BMLED-20080723AAU).
