On the behalf of **Smile Broadcasting, LLC**, ("Smile"), the Licensee of WSLK (AM), Moneta, Virginia (FAC# 31212) ("WSLK"), this is to respectfully request an Extension Special Temporary Authority ("STA") granted in BESTA-20220524AAA. Attached hereto is the previous STA. As previously advised, Smile lost its tower site and in now operating from a temporary location at reduced power. Dear Mr. Ernandes:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 24, 2022. Smile requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 8, 2021, to continue operating with the long wire antenna at an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application (due to loss of the licensed transmitter site). In support of the request, Smile stated that additional time will be required to file the application to propose a new permanent facility (after obtaining zoning approval for a new site).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and Smile may continue to operate with the following facilities:
