

Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority

Dear Ms. Dortch:

iHM Licenses, LLC ("iHM"), licensee of WIOD(AM), Miami, Florida, by its counsel, hereby requests an extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for the station to operate at variance from its license to negate the effects of destructive Cuban interference. An STA, BESTA-20220726AAH, was granted on August 11, 2022, for a period expiring on February 10, 2023.

Under the STA, WIOD is permitted to operate with the 10 kW patterns specified in BMML-20170426ACK using the existing licensed site. Because the destructive Cuban interference continues to disrupt WIOD(AM)'s operations, iHM respectfully requests an extension of its STA while construction of WIOD's new site under BP-20170406AAD continues.¹

The licensee has authorized undersigned counsel to certify on its behalf that the licensee is not subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
