Dear Madam Secretary:

On behalf of John Ostlund and Katrina Ostlund, licensee of the above-referenced station, you are respectfully requested to extend special temporary authority for station KYNO to operate nondirectional at 25% of licensed power using licensed tower #2 while maintaining monitor points due to ground system vandalism including copper theft.

The KYNO ground system has been vandalized by copper thieves preventing the station from operating at full licensed parameters. During the most recent STA period, the station has been pursuing insurance claim matters which the licensee optimistically anticipates may soon be reaching resolution. After insurance matters are resolved, the station will begin the process of ordering materials necessary to complete repairs and resume operation at licensed parameters. Until repairs may be completed, KYNO seeks continued STA to operate nondirectional at 25% of licensed power using licensed tower #2 (ASRN 1013935) while maintaining monitor points.

STA is in the public interest so that the station may continue to broadcast important information to its listening audience until repairs or potential station modifications may be completed.

Applicant certifies that neither applicant nor any party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
