Dear Mr..Miniard:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 30, 2023. UME requests an extension of the STA granted on August 8, 2022, to continue operating with a long wire antenna from an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application to propose a new permanent facility.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, UME stated that it plans to file the application with the AudioFilings team as soon as possible (due to the loss of the licensed transmitter site).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and UME may continue to operate with the following facilities:



UME must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.
