Description: REASONS FOR STA EXTENSION

AS PREVIOUSLY ADVISED IN INITIAL STA, LICENSEE HAS BEEN EVICTED FROM LICENSED TOWER SITE AND HAS APPLIED FOR AND RECEIVED A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FOR MODIFICATION OF LICENSE (BP-20210617AAA) FOR A NEW PERMANENT FACILITY. IN ORDER TO AVOID GOING SILENT WHILE AWAITING COMPLETION OF THE ABOVE CP CONSTRUCTION, LICENSEE SEEKS TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE FROM CO-OWNED WTOX USING FACILITIES AS DESCRIBED IN ORIGINAL STA AS AN INTERIM MEASURE. WVNZ INTENDED TO TRIPLEX UNDER BP-20210617AAA HOWEVER THE COST OF KINTRONICS PHASING UNIT AND FILTERS/INSTALLATION HAS INCREASED OVER \$50,000 IN THE INTERIM MAKING THE TRIPLEX INSTALLATION IMPOSSIBLE UNDER CURRENT FINANCIAL CONDITIONS. LICENSEE IS NOW SEEKING A DIPLEX PARTNER AS KINTRONICS COST WILL BE LESS FOR A SIMPLE DIPLEX OPERATION AND WILL BE FILING A CP MODIFICATION APPLICATION TO BP-20210617AAA ONCE PARAMETERS ARE DETERMINED.
