February 2023 Update: The Licensee herein reports on further progress it has made since its prior STA request (see File No. 20220810AAI) and respectfully requests an additional extension of STA to continue operating at its current parameters for an additional 180 days.

Since the Licensee's most recent STA extension request, the Commission granted the Licensee's Application in FCC File Number 20220603AAC and has issued the Licensee a construction permit to co-locate (diplex) its commonly-owned station WKAV(AM), Facility ID Number 10651, with WCHV(AM). The Licensee is now undertaking to construct both facilities (i.e., WCHV(AM) and WKAV(AM)) and to subsequently file License Applications regarding same.

In terms of progress in support of such construction, the Licensee can report that the equipment to co-locate the facilities has been designed; the Licensee expects an order for the equipment will be finalized soon. Once such order has been placed, the Licensee anticipates manufacture of the equipment will take approximately 90 days. In addition, the Licensee has contacted tower climbers regarding moving forward with the removal of the towers, which removal is needed in order to satisfy the conditions of the construction permit to diplex the commonly-owned stations.

Grant of further extension of STA to continue operating at no more than 25% of authorized power for an additional 180 days will allow WCHV(AM) to continue serving its community of license. Additionally, WCHV(AM)'s program services remain available to listeners via the Licensee's FM station WCHV-FM (Facility ID No. 61716) as well as the internet.
