

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This request is filed on behalf of Salem Communications Holding Corporation ("SCHC"), licensee of WTLN(AM), Orlando, FL, facility ID 23442. WTLN is currently operating in nondirectional mode at 25% of licensed power per BESTA-20220902AAA due to fire damage at one of the station's broadcast towers and additionally, damage to a portion of the station's ground system by an outside contractor. Substantial progress has been made toward the restoration of the station's licensed facilities, with all ground system repairs and the majority (90-95%) of all other work completed. SCHC expects to have all restoration work completed in the next 30 days and will begin testing to determine if the facility is operating in compliance with the station's licensed parameters. Considering the current status of this effort, SCHC respectfully requests an additional 90 day extension of the STA to allow time for any unexpected issues to be addressed and to allow WTLN to continue uninterrupted operation with reduced power (25%) of licensed in non-directional mode or with parameters at variance during testing and evaluation of the repaired directional antenna system while maintaining all monitor points at or below licensed values.

The licensee has authorized undersigned counsel to certify on its behalf that the licensee is not subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
