Dear Mr. Hearne:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 14, 2023. GCB requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 5, 2019, to request a change from DA parameters at variance to ND operation to allow time to file an FCC Form 301 minor change application to permanently modify the licensed facility due to recurring flooding damage. In support of the request, GCB stated that additional time will be needed to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and GCB may now operate ND with 1 kW using one of the licensed site towers. GCB must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. GCB must submit a brief e-mail to my attention to note the date the FCC Form 301 application was filed, or to note the date an FCC Form 302 application was filed with a new method of moment proof (if the directional
