WSKO(AM) Technical Narrative

Radio License Holding CBC, LLC (“RLH-CBC”), licensee of Station WSKO(AM), Syracuse, New York, respectfully requests a further extension of its Special Temporary Authorization (“STA”) to continue to operate with twenty-five percent (25%) of its authorized nighttime power or 1.25 kW in the non-directional mode, pursuant to Sections 73.1635 and 73.1560 of the Commission’s rules.

WSKO is licensed to operate on frequency 1260 kHz with five kiloWatts (5 kW) of power during daytime and nighttime hours utilizing a four-tower directional array. As reported previously, RLH-CBCs’ local engineers determined that the sample lines and antenna monitor needed to be replaced and the ground system needed repair. Its engineers took care of these replacements and repairs, received instructions from its consultant, Carl T. Jones, about the measurements needed, and began taking directional antenna measurements. Unfortunately, poor weather in the northeast interfered with this process. RLH-CBC engineers are hoping better weather will allow them to finish measurements in the coming weeks so they can work with the consultant to complete and file a license application to update its operating parameters.

Accordingly, RLH-CBC respectfully requests an extension of its STA to permit WSKO to operate with 1.25 kW of power at night in the non-directional mode. This will allow the Station to continue to provide nighttime service to its listeners until it is able to finish measurements and file a license application with the FCC.
