Dear Mr. Denning:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 11, 2023. Cumulus requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 23, 2017, to continue operating with a reduced power of 0.6 kW to allow time to tune its new antenna tuning unit.¹ In support of the request, Cumulus stated that additional time is needed before it can resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and Cumulus may continue to operate with parameters at variance and a reduced power of 0.6 kW. Cumulus must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. Cumulus must submit a brief e-mail to my attention to note the date an FCC Form 302 application was filed to update all engineering parameters, or to note the date the station was able to resume

licensed operations with negligible changes to all engineering parameters as shown on the last license BL-20170404AAU.

This authority expires on October 22, 2023. 2
