We are continuing to make good progress on the KOKC site rebuild. In addition to the three new towers, new ATU buildings, and transmission lines, we have completed the ground system, fences and protective cages. We are close to finishing he Phasor and ATU's, but we are waiting on three RF coils and four capacitors. We're also waiting on the return of our TCT's and base current meter that are being recalibrated. We will need to tune the array and complete a MOM proof. It's unlikely that we will be able to accomplish this by the end of our current STA. We anticipate the remaining work will take 60 days. We are requesting that the Commission grant us an additional STA. We appreciate your consideration.
