KXPA(AM) Narrative

MULTICULTURAL RADIO BROADCASTING LICENSEE, LLC ('MRBL'), RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF KXPA(AM)'S SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORIZATION ('STA') TO OPERATE AT TWENTY FIVE PERCENT (25%) OF ITS LICENSED POWER IN THE NON-DIRECTIONAL MODE DURING NIGHTTIME HOURS.

MRBL INDICATED PREVIOUSLY THAT THE SOUND TRANSIT PROJECT AFFECTED THE ELECTRICAL ENVIRONMENT AND OPERATION OF KXPA. SINCE FILING ITS NOVEMBER 2022 REQUEST TO EXTEND ITS STA, MRBL HAS ADVANCED THE KXPA TECHNICAL PROJECT AND CAN REPORT SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS. KINTRONICS FINISHED BUILDING THE KXPA REPLACEMENT PHASER, IT WAS DELIVERED ON SITE AND INSTALLED. CONSTRUCTION OF THE TOWERS WERE FINISHED. MRBL WAS HOPEFUL THAT HATFIELD & DAWSON WOULD BE ABLE TUNE THE ARRAY BY NOW BUT INCLEMENT WEATHER AND SCHEDULING PROBLEMS CAUSED DELAY. The NEW PHASER AND CABLES ARE IN WORKING ORDER AND THE TRANSMITTERS ARE ALSO WORKING PROPERLY. MRBL EXPECTS THE TUNING WILL BE COMPLETED VERY SOON.

ACCORDINGLY, MRBL RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF ITS STA, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 73.1635 AND 73.1680(A)(1) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES, TO OPERATE KXPA WITH TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT (25%) POWER IN THE NONDIRECTIONAL MODE DURING NIGHTTIME HOURS.
