Dear Ms. Repp:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned minor change application filed by Owl Broadcasting & Development, Inc. to change the daytime pattern, city of license, and eliminate the nighttime facility; and the June 7, 2007, amendment.

A preliminary review of the amended application reveals that this proposal was notified to Mexico on Change List #3065, and in letter No. 2227 the Mexican Government objected to the KSAZ(AM) proposal because it would cause objectionable daytime interference to co-channel stations XEFI, Chihuahua, Chihuahua, and XEHO, Cd Obregon, Sonora; and first adjacent station XEUK, Caborca, Sonora. As a result, the application must be amended to eliminate all Mexican problems. All questions concerning protection to Mexican stations should be directed to George Fehlner at (202)418-2197. In addition, the application must be amended to include the missing tower registration numbers.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file an electronic amendment. Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a).
