Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 24, 2023. IHM requests a further extension of the STA granted on October 14, 2020, to continue operating ND at night with reduced power to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application. In support of the request, IHM stated that additional time is needed to complete all remaining modifications/repairs in order to file the application to update all engineering parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and IHM may continue to operate ND at night using the daytime tower with a reduced power of 0.125 kW, with no changes to the daytime 5 kW ND operation. IHM must reduce the nighttime power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the
