Dear Ms. Sanders:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 21, 2023. LCI requests a further extension of the STA granted on July 13, 2022, to continue operating from an alternate site with a long wire antenna to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application. In support of the request, LCI stated that although progress has been made over the past 6 months, additional time will be needed to complete all remaining construction steps before filing the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
 the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
 the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and LCI may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates 30° 26′ 53″ N, 84° 15′ 37″ W (NAD 1927)

Frequency 1450 kHz Hours of operation Unlimited

Operating power 0.250 kW (day and night)

¹ WTAL(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1450 kHz with 1 kW day and night, and BP-20220407AAH authorizes 1 kW ND operation day and night using the existing WTYL tower.

Antenna type

29 m long wire mounted 30 feet AGL and stretching from the studio building to a support pole with guy wires

LCI must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on January 6, 2024. ²
