Dear Mr. Dawson:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 12, 2023. CCR requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 14, 2022, to continue operating with reduced daytime power to allow time to complete all remaining tests before filing the required direct measurement of power application. In support of the request, CCR stated all damaged equipment has been replaced or repaired, and additional field monitoring tests must be performed before it can file the application to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
  the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
  the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and CCR may continue to operate with parameters at variance using the daytime DA pattern with a reduced nominal power

of 1.3 kW (with no change to the licensed nighttime 0.062 kW operation). CCR must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on January 17, 2024. <sup>2</sup>

The records shall include start/stop dates and times of such operation. These log entries must be maintained for a minimum of two years as specified in 47 CFR § 73.1840(a), unless a longer retention period is requested by the staff. Periods of operation may be subject to independent verification that they in fact occurred.
