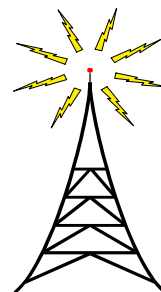

Antenna Resistance
July 24, 2023**

The WGTJ antenna resistance changed due to the installation of a translator antenna and isocoupler on the tower. A new antenna coupling unit was also installed. The resistance and reactance of the WGTJ antenna were measured, using a Hewlett Packard 8753C network analyzer. Immediately prior to the measurement, the analyzer and test leads were calibrated, using NIST traceable standards.

The antenna coupling unit J-Plug was removed from the output jack and the test lead clips were attached the tower side of the test jack and the output ground terminal.

The measured impedance is 14.25-j108.36 ohms.
