Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ^{1/}the LICENSEE

HUNTINGTON COUNTY COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORP.

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term beginning May 13, 1970 and ending August 1, 1970

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

1. On a frequency of 91.9 megacycles;
Effective radiated power of 920 watts;
Antenna height above average terrain of 110 feet.
2. Transmitter output power 240 watts.
3. Hours of operation: Unlimited time.
4. With the station located at:

ANTENNA: GATES, Type No. FMA-4A, 4 sections.

ANTENNA SUPPORTING STRUCTURE: FM antenna side-mounted near the top of a 120' uniform cross-section guyed tower.

OVERALL HEIGHT ABOVE GROUND: 120 feet.

The Commission reserves the right during said license period of terminating this license or making effective any changes or modification of this license which may be necessary to comply with any decision of the Commission rendered as a result of any hearing held under the rules of the Commission prior to the commencement of this license period or any decision rendered as a result of any such hearing which has been designated but not held, prior to the commencement of this license period.

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
