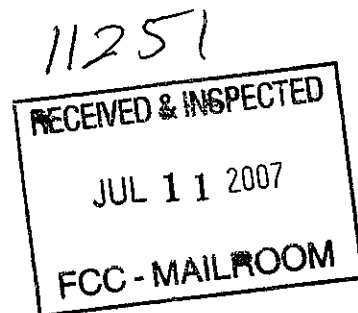

The facility continues to operate without interruption within the terms and conditions of its license.
