Dear Mr. MacIntosh:

This letter concerns the request, filed on May 30, 2008, on behalf of Horizon Christian Fellowship ("HCF"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K237EX to remain silent.

HCF's request states that K237EX went silent on April 2, 2008, in anticipation of filing an application to assign the station to Minnesota Public Radio in order to conserve financial resources. HCF's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

HCF's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit FM Translator Station K237EX to remain silent for a period not to exceed April 2, 2009. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for K237EX will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. April 3, 2009.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).


The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of

applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
