Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned modification application for AM broadcast station WCMA.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 17.4(a), any proposed construction of a new antenna structure or proposed alteration of an existing antenna structure that requires notification to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires registration with the Commission prior to the proposed construction or alteration. Our records indicate that the proposed antenna structure has not been registered with the Commission. The proposed 58.52 meters tower has failed the "Slope Test". Therefore, registration is required. FCC antenna structure registration may be accomplished electronically via the Internet at <http://www.fcc.gov/wtb/antenna/>, or by sending a completed FCC Form 854, *Application for Antenna Structure Registration*, to:

Please note that FAA approval is necessary in order to obtain FCC antenna structure registration. Following FCC registration of the antenna structure, a curative amendment to the application, which includes the antenna structure registration number, must be submitted to the Commission so that processing of your application may be completed. If the antenna structure cannot be registered within 30 days of the date of this letter, the applicant must notify the Audio Services Division (ASD), in writing, concerning the delay.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of 30 days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to respond. Failure to respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1).

Please note that any amendment must be submitted in the same manner as the original application.
