Dear Mr. Hayley:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned application to relocate from the present licensed transmitter site of WQNR.¹

This application was filed two days after application BPH-20060911AAY for WKGA (Facility ID. No. 15283), Dadeville, AL and conflicted with the earlier filed application. Under the Commission's processing system for FM commercial minor change applications, FM commercial minor change applications are processed on a first come / first served basis. Later filed applications are "held in queue" behind the first-filed or lead application.² If the lead application is granted, the queue is dissolved and the queue applications are dismissed; if the lead application is dismissed, then the first queue application (the application filed closest in time after the lead application) is processed.

In the present instance, the staff granted the lead application BPH-20060911AAY on November 20, 2006. As a result, the first come / first served queue is dissolved. Application BPH-20060913ACA, as a part of that queue, IS DISMISSED.
