Dear Mr. Riehm:

This is in reference to the above-captioned license application and to the request for program test authority for radio station KNSN(AM), San Diego, California.

Program test authority is granted KNSN(AM) to conduct program tests through **May 29, 2009**, in accordance with Section 73.1620 of the Commission's rules and Construction Permit BP-20080306AAT to operate on 1240 kHz with a daytime and nighttime nominal power of 550 watts. Program tests are authorized with a daytime and nighttime antenna input power of 550 watts and an antenna input current of 4.36 amperes.

A preliminary review of the license application reveals that the co-located station KURS(AM) has not filed an application to return to direct measurement of power (FCC Form 302) as required by condition #3. Consequently, we shall withhold action on the license application until the KURS 302 application is filed.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for thirty days from the date of this letter in order to provide an opportunity to file a curative amendment. Failure to respond or file an amendment within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the rules.
