Dear Applicant:

We are currently processing your above-referenced application. Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. KKTU, Colorado Springs, CO. – BLCT-1511 at 3.5%
2. KQCK, Cheyenne, WY. – BPCDT-20080620AAP at 0.9% & BLCDT-20040513ABA at 1.8%

In addition to the above referenced interference issues, our preliminary engineering review reveals that you are proposing to increase the towers overall height above ground (AGL) by 1.3 meters as shown below:

The overall height above ground (AGL) as indicated on the above referenced construction permit is 97 meters.

If you are not planning to increase the overall height above ground (AGL) by 1.3 meters and the figure entered on the above referenced construction permit is in error, you will need to file an electronic amendment to the proposed construction permit to correct the overall height of the tower or if you are actually planning to increase the overall height above ground (AGL) by 1.3 meters, the new tower height requires registration and approval by the FAA and an electronic amendment filed to indicate the new registration information.

You are hereby given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified interference problems and the tower height issue within (30) days from the date of this letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.
