Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application filed to modify the broadcast facilities of WOGH(FM).

Pursuant to Section 17.4(a) of the Commission's Rules,¹ any proposed construction of a new antenna structure or proposed alteration of an existing antenna structure that requires notification to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requires registration with the Commission prior to construction or alteration. The application indicates that notification has been filed with the FAA, but there has been no showing of status nor has there been an amendment filed supplying the required registration number. Further inquiry of the FAA notification system indicates that on March 26, 2008, the FAA issued a determination of no hazard to air navigation. However, as of the date of this letter the tower has not yet been registered. Multiple status requests by the staff have failed to result in a registered tower. Furthermore, WOGH has not provided an update on their efforts to resolve the situation in over six months.

Accordingly, to date, over two years have passed since the application claimed that notification has been filed with the FAA without the tower being registered. Therefore, in light of the above, application BPH-20050623AAG is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568(a)(1) and is HEREBY DISMISSED for failure to prosecute an application. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
