Dear Licensee:

This refers to the above-captioned application filed on behalf of K33AO, Coos Bay, Oregon, for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) for this station to remain silent. The application states that the station has been silent since March 4, 2008.

Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, provides in pertinent part that if a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license shall expire at the end of that period.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, the license for station K33AO IS FORFEITED, and the call sign IS HEREBY DELETED. Moreover, in view of this action, the above-captioned application for Special Temporary Authority for the station to remain silent is moot, and IS HEREBY DIMISSED.
