Dear Mr. Madden:

This is in reference to the above-captioned application for a new AM radio station at Holt, Alabama. The application is a studied pursuant to a Commission Public Notice listing mutually exclusive applications in AM Auction No 84.¹

A preliminary study of the application reveals that the proposed 0.025 mV/m and 0.5 mV/m daytime groundwave contours would respectively overlap the 0.5 mV/m and 0.025 mV/m daytime groundwave contours of co-channel station WJAM, Selma, Alabama; and the proposed 0.025 mV/m daytime groundwave contour would overlap the 0.5 mV/m daytime groundwave contour of co-channel station WFEB, Sylacauga, Alabama, in contravention of Section 73.37 of the Commission's rules. In addition, an environmental study is not provided as the applicant answered "No" on Item 11 of Section III-A of the FCC Form 301 (Environmental Protection Act).

Accordingly, further action on the subject application will be withheld for thirty (30) days from the date of this letter in order to provide an opportunity to file a curative electronic amendment. Failure to respond or file an amendment within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
