Dear Mr. Guel:

Commission records show that in August 2007, Hispanic Christian Community Network, Inc. ("HCCN") acquired a construction permit for a new low power television station on channel 30 at Carrara, Nevada (formerly K30IG). That construction permit had an expiration date of December 15, 2007.² HCCN filed a license to cover construction of the station in December 2007,³ and that application was granted in February 2008.

The Commission has now received a complaint that the station was not constructed. Specifically, a member of the public has informed the Commission that he visited the authorized KPVE-LP transmitter site in April 2009 and that there was no tower or other structure on which an antenna could be mounted, nor were there power lines anywhere in the area. He also stated that he was unable to find any broadcast signal on channel 30, using a spectrum analyzer and television receiver.

It appears from the foregoing that HCCN may have falsely certified in its license application that it had met all the terms, conditions, and obligations set forth in its construction permit. As part of our ongoing investigation of this matter, we require certain information regarding the recent operations of KPVE-LP. This information must be supported by affidavit of you or your agent with personal knowledge thereof. We request that the following documents and information be provided within fifteen (15) business days from the date of this letter:

(1) Was KPVE-LP constructed and operated in accordance with all terms, conditions and obligations set forth in its construction permit? If so, provide documentation establishing the dates on which KPVE-LP operated, such as a copy of any lease agreements for use of the authorized transmitter site,

- agreements regarding the construction of KPVE-LP, utility bills, and affidavits of persons responsible for the construction and continuing operation of the station. You must also provide the name and telephone number of the contact person for the transmitter site.
- (2) If KPVE-LP was not constructed and operated in accordance with all terms, conditions and obligations set forth in the construction permit, identify all persons who took part in the decision to file the license application, and explain the basis for the decision to file a license to cover the construction of a facility that was not actually constructed. Also provide any written materials, including correspondence, notes and email messages that pertain to the filing of the license application.

Failure to provide the following information, supported by the affidavit of a person with personal knowledge, may result in cancellation of the KPVE-LP license.
