Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to the above-captioned application, filed on your behalf, for a license to cover the construction of modified facilities for Station KCIO-LP, Victorville, California. An objection to that application was filed by Venture Technologies Group, LLC (VTG).

In its objection, VTG alleges that KCIO-LP was not constructed and, that by filing the license application, you falsely certified that station was constructed as authorized. In a response to the objection filed on your behalf, it is stated, among other things, that the facilities were not built as authorized and that the station operated with those facilities between October 24 and November 18, 2008. It is also reported that the station thereafter resumed operations from its currently authorized transmitter site until such time as the licensee constructs the modified facilities in accordance with the construction permit and files a new license application. Therefore, it is requested that the above-captioned license application be withdrawn.¹

As part of our investigation of this matter, we require certain information regarding the construction and operation of this station. This information must be supported by affidavit of the licensee or other officer or employee with personal knowledge thereof. We request that you provide the following information and appropriate documentation within fifteen (15) business days from the date of this letter:

1. Please provide specific information describing the technical operation of your station between October 24 and November 18, 2008. This information should include identification and a description of the equipment used, your antenna and tower site, the effective radiated power, and HAAT.

2. Please provide a description of the nature or type, and duration of any programming broadcast by the station during the station's on-air operation.

3. Please provide the names and title and specific duties of any station personnel involved with the supervision, construction and operation of the station.

4. Please provide the commission with any correspondence, documents station records, or any other written material verifying the station's on-air operation.

We direct the licensee to support its responses with an affidavit or declaration under penalty of perjury, signed and dated by an authorized officer of the licensee with personal knowledge of the representations provided in the responses, verifying the truth and accuracy of the information therein.

Your responses should be filed within 15 days from the date of this letter. Failure to provide the requested information will result in the denial of any pending requests for authority or relief.
