## Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application for W214BE, Raymond, MS.

An engineering study reveals that the application fails to comply with 47 C.F.R. § 74.1205 with respect to TV Channel Six Station WABG(TV), Greenwood, MS. Specifically, our calculations show that there is overlap between the Grade B contour (47 dBu) of WABG(TV) and the proposed interfering contour (77 dBu). This constitutes an acceptance defect.

In light of the above, the application BPFT-20090409APP is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and is HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.

However, all TV Channel 6 Stations must be protected until further notice. See Letter to Family Life Educational Foundation, DA 08-626 (rel.
