
Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application for W214BE, Raymond, MS.

An engineering study reveals that the application fails to comply with 47 C.F.R. § 74.1205 with respect to TV Channel Six Station WABG(TV), Greenwood, MS. Specifically, our calculations show that there is overlap between the Grade B contour (47 dBu) of WABG(TV) and the proposed interfering contour (77 dBu).¹ This constitutes an acceptance defect.

In light of the above, the application BPFT-20090409APP is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and is HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.

¹ The application states that WABG(TV) Channel 6 has terminated operations on February 17, 2009 and since the proposed application was filed after the 30 day nite light period, WABG(TV) has ceased all operation on Channel 6. However, all TV Channel 6 Stations must be protected until further notice. See *Letter to Family Life Educational Foundation*, DA 08-626 (rel.
