Dear Mr. Rivera:

This is in reference to the request filed April 14, 2009<sup>1</sup>, on behalf of Centro Colegial Cristiano, Inc. ("CCC"). CCC requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on December 26, 2007, to operate Station WVID with reduced power.<sup>2</sup>

In support of the request, CCC provides a report of its repair efforts.

We note that the previous STA expired on January 17, 2009. Our review indicates that the circumstances presented warrant grant of STA in order to provide for service to the public, and that the requested STA facilities are the same as were previously authorized. However, in light of the lapse of time between the expiration of the prior STA and the filing of the instant request, it will be considered as a request for a new STA; the authority granted will not cover the period between the expiration of the prior STA and the filing of the instant request.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WVID may operate with reduced power. CCC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. CCC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio

frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. The authority granted herein does not cover the period between January 17, 2009, and April 14, 2009, and is without prejudice as to whatever action the Commission may take with respect to operation of Station WVID during the foregoing period.

This authority expires on **November 21, 2009**.
