Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed June 23, 2008, on behalf of Bay Cities Building Company, Inc. ("BCBC"). BCBC requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on March 27, 2008, to operate Station KDCQ with reduced power.¹

In support of the request, BCBC states that an insurance issue continues to delay ordering of replacement, full-power equipment after a fire destroyed the station's transmitting equipment on March 2, 2008.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

¹ KDCQ is licensed for operation on Channel 225C3 (92.9 MHz) with effective radiated power of 4.5 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 160 meters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KDCQ may continue to operate with reduced power. BCBC must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. BCBC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 22, 2009**.
