Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned application for a minor change to a licensed facility to serve Yuma, AZ.

An engineering review of the application reveals that the application is in violation of the *AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED MEXICAN STATES RELATING TO THE FM BROADCASTING SERVICE IN THE BAND 88-108 MHZ* (USA-Mexico Agreement). Specifically, the proposal is short-spaced to the third-adjacent channel Class B1 Mexican allotment in San Luis Rio Colorado, Sonora, MX. Furthermore, the proposed interfering contour (97 dBu) would cause prohibited contour overlap to the Mexican allotment's protected contour (57 dBu). Thus, the application fails to comply with the USA-Mexico Agreement.

In light of the above, Application BPED-20070907ABF is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and is **HEREBY DISMISSED**. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
