Special Temporary Authority

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed October 9, 2008, on behalf of KRBE Lico, Inc. ("KLI"). KLI requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on April 11, 2008, to operate Station KTCK with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680. In support of the request, KLI provides a report on its progress toward reconstructing three of its towers which were destroyed by a severe storm.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made substantial progress toward restoring licensed operation. Thus, extension of STA is warranted. In light of the progress reported, STA will be expanded to include authority for directional operation with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, with modification as

discussed above. Station KTCK may operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. Operation with an emergency nondirectional antenna and reduced power not to exceed 2.25 kilowatts daytime and 1.25 kilowatts nighttime also is authorized, as necessary to facilitate the restoration of licensed operation. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. KLI must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. KLI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on December 24, 2009.
