
Dear Applicant:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application for W290BN, Knoxville, TN.

An engineering study of the application reveals that it is in violation of 47 C.F.R. § 74.1204(a) with respect to WLHR-LP (BLL-20050308AAV), Maryville, TN. Section 74.1204(a) states that an application for an FM translator station will not be accepted if the proposed operation would involve prohibited overlap of predicted field strength contours with any other authorized station; or if it would result in new or increased overlap with an LP100 station. Specifically, the proposed interfering contour (40 dBu) will cause prohibited overlap to WLHR-LP's protected contour (60 dBu). Accordingly, the application fails to demonstrate compliance with 74.1204(a) and will be dismissed.

In light of the above, the application BPFT-20090518AHO is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and is HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
