Dear Mr. Glinter:

This letter concerns the request, filed on August 11, 2008, on behalf of Nationwide Inspirational Broadcasting for Special Temporary Authority to permit Station WDLG(FM) to remain silent.

Nationwide Inspirational Broadcasting's request states that WDLG(FM) went silent on August 11, 2008, due to financial reasons. Nationwide Inspirational Broadcasting's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

Nationwide Inspirational Broadcasting's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WDLG(FM) to remain silent for a period not to exceed August 11, 2009. Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for WDLG(FM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. August 12, 2009. See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

²Notification of resumption of broadcast operations must be mailed to:

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
