Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed March 12, 2009, on behalf of Jacor Broadcasting Corporation ("Jacor"). Jacor requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on September 26, 2008, to operate Station WSAI with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.¹ In support of the request, Jacor states that the station's elevated ground system was damaged by high winds. Jacor states that, during the initial STA period it cleaned up the damaged area, had a land survey performed and completed the design of the replacement system. Jacor states that a contract has been signed for the replacement and repair work and that the work will begin soon.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is

¹ WSAI is licensed for operation on 1360 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 5 kilowatts nighttime, employing a directional antenna during nighttime hours only (DA-N-U).

warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WSAI may continue to operate during nighttime hours with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.² It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Jacor must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.³ Jacor must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 21, 2010**.

² The daytime nondirectional antenna may, if necessary, be operated via the indirect method of determining operating power, pursuant to Section 73.51(d). STA is not necessary for this mode of operation.
