Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed April 21, 2009, on behalf of Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses, Inc. ("CCBL"), for extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on October 30, 2008, to operate Station WFLF pursuant to Section 73.1615.<sup>1</sup>

Our review indicates that, subsequent to the filing of the instant extension request, CCBL completed construction of its modified facilities. CCBL filed an application for license as well as an application for augmentation of the authorized standard pattern. Our review further indicates that CCBL was granted Program Test Authority for operation with its modified facilities by staff letter dated July 14, 2009. In light of the foregoing action, STA is no longer necessary.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY DISMISSED.

<sup>1</sup> WFLF is licensed for operation on 540 kHz with 50 kilowatts daytime and 50 kilowatts nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns daytime and nighttime (DA-2-U). Construction Permit BP-20051101ABN authorizes relocation of the transmitter, a reduction in nighttime power to 46 kilowatts and changes to the daytime and nighttime directional patterns.
