Special Temporary Authority

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 16, 2009, on behalf of Aleluya Christian Broadcasting, Inc. ("ACB"). ACB requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on October 16, 2008, to operate Station KUZN with reduced power. In support of the request, ACB states that it is waiting on a new transmitter and electrical work which will allow it to resume operation with full licensed power.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KUZN may commtinue to operate with reduced power. ACB must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. ACB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the

public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR \S 1.1310.

This authority expires on February 4, 2010.
